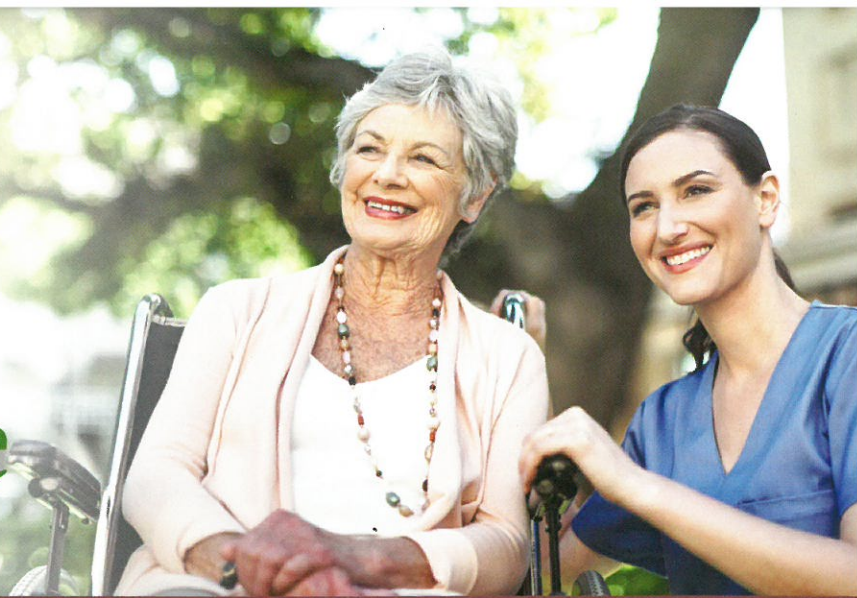


Bethania Well, Green Space & Fish Pond Drive

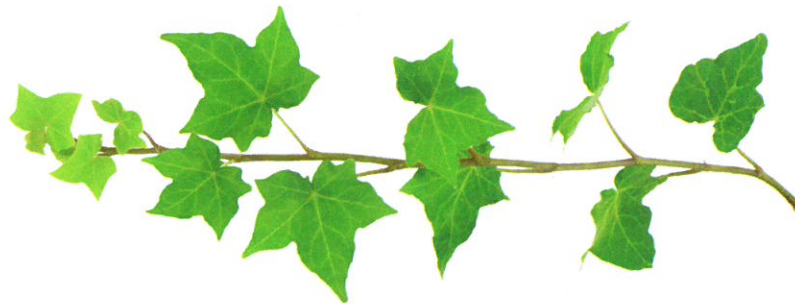
