Dear Residents and Families:

First and foremost, I am very pleased to note all Bethania Residents and Staff remain COVID free as of this date. We thank God for this blessing.

Here are a few other important updates:

- All Residents who had consent received their second dose of the Pfizer COVID -19 vaccine on February 12th. As more than seven days has past following these immunizations, our Residents have up to a 95% level of protection from contracting a COVID infection.
- The In Room visits began this **Monday, February 22nd** for the two Designated Family Caregivers. It has been wonderful to see our families back visiting with their loved ones in person. We can already see the positive effects on our Residents.
- Shared Health has announced that we are now able to invite our Hairdresser to resume work in our facility. She will begin appointments on March 3rd.
- As the vast majority of our Residents have been immunized, we will be resuming our usual meal service process in the main dining room and in the satellite dining areas on March 8th. We know that the Residents will welcome this return to a normal dining experience off of the Wings.
- Finally, In Door Visits in the “TeaHaus” are now available for other family members and general visitors. Appointments can be made on our website www.bethania.ca. We will provide visitors with masks and hand sanitation. We look forward to welcoming you back!
