Dear Residents and Families:

First and foremost, I am very pleased to note all Pembina Place Residents and Staff remain COVID free as of this date. We thank God for this blessing.

Here are a few other important updates:

- All Residents who had consent received their second dose of the Pfizer COVID -19 vaccine on **February 10<sup>th</sup>**. As more than seven days has past following these immunizations, our Residents have up to a 95% level of protection from contracting a COVID infection.
- The In Room visits began this **Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>** for the two Designated Family Caregivers. It has been wonderful to see our families back visiting with their loved ones in person. We can already see the positive effects on our Residents.
- Shared Health has announced that we are now able to allow a Hairdresser to resume work in our facility. Because of the single site staff restriction we had to hire a new hairdresser. Wendy Halliday will be providing hair care services to the residents beginning the first week of March.
- Finally, In Door Visits on the second floor “Friendship Room” are now available for other family members and general visitors.
